UK Youth for Nature is a network of 16-35-year-olds from across the UK calling on the government to act on the nature crisis. Founded in 2019, we specialise in highly creative campaigns that platform youth voices around environmental policy making and work to engage and upskill young campaigners. We have a small team of part-time paid staff and a volunteer organising team who lead on our campaigns. Our current campaigns are focused on agricultural pollution in freshwater ecosystems and urban pesticide use.

The role

We are looking for three new board members to join our Board of Trustees. The Board of is responsible for overseeing the organisation's activities, impact and development by offering guidance and support to the executive team. Formal board meetings are held online, four times a year on a weekday evening.

We are seeking board members who work both within and outside of the environmental sector and are particularly keen to hear from applicants from underrepresented groups. UKY4N is a network of 16-35-year-olds and we ask that all applicants for the role of trustee are over 16. Applicants do not need to be under 35 to join our board.

We are seeking someone who:

- Has experience in any of the following areas:
 - Financial management, bookkeeping and overseeing charity accounts
 - Equality, Diversity and Inclusion
 - Campaigning
 - Organisational development
- Is sympathetic to the aims of UK Youth for Nature
- Works well with a remote team

What will you gain from this role?

This is an opportunity to support young people's voices who are calling for greater environmental protection. Gain experience in organisational governance and work alongside leading experts in the campaigning and environmental policy space.
